Policy

1. No discipline decision (including its reasons) will be published in the newsletter of the College, on the College website, or on the Canadian Legal Information Institute (CanLII) until the thirty (30) day appeal period has expired.
2. If, after the expiry of the thirty (30) day appeal period, no appeal has been filed by the registrant, the decision and reasons will be published in the newsletter of the College, on the College website, and on CanLII, and the registrant's name will be published if otherwise permitted by Section 56(2) of the Health Professions Procedural Code, being Schedule 2 of the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*.
3. If the registrant has given notice of an appeal within the thirty (30) day appeal period, the decision and reasons will be published in the newsletter of the College, on the College website, and on CanLII, but the registrant's name will not be published until the appeal has been disposed of.
